# King's Christian School Hawaii ELEMENTARY CONDUCT AGREEMENT

I believe the Bible teaches that Christians are to be different from non-Christians. "Be transformed by the renewing of your mind." Romans 12:2 I have asked Jesus to take over my life as Savior and Lord. Therefore, it is my desire to make every effort to obey His commands by living a life pleasing to Him. In an effort to be an example of a Christian disciple under authority, I will observe the following whether at home, at school or elsewhere:

#### **ELEMENTARY**

I will keep myself from swearing or using any bad language. I will not participate in gambling, social dancing or secular music. I will not make light of or discuss sinful actions or products, either by word or on paper. I will work hard to maintain Christian standards by being courteous, kind and honest. I will have a good attitude and will accept loving correction when needed. I will honor God trying my best to do well in all subjects. I will attend a regular church service weekly.

I sincerely desire a school with a Christian atmosphere, and therefore agree to abide by the code of conduct and all other rules and regulations set forth in the Student Handbook of King's Christian School Hawaii. I understand that failure to adhere to the principles of this agreement can be grounds for suspension or dismissal.

#### **PARENTS**

As a parent, I have read the standards of conduct, the rules and regulations in the Student Handbook, and the Statement of Faith. Realizing the parents' influence on their children, I agree to require my child to abide by the KCSH code of conduct and will cooperate and support the school by maintaining these standards at all times.

Sanctification is an act of separation from that which is evil, and of dedication unto God. The Scriptures teach a life of holiness because "without holiness no one will see the Lord." (Heb. 12:4) By the power of the Holy Spirit we are able to obey the command: "Be holy, because I am holy." (1 Peter 1:15-16)

Sanctification is realized in the believer by recognizing his identification with Christ in His death and resurrection, and by faith reckoning daily upon the fact of that union, and by offering every faculty continually to be under the dominion of the Holy Spirit. One aspect of holiness is not doing what is evil.

Another aspect of holiness is seeing all human life as sacred and created by God in His image. We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. (Gen. 1:26-27) Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person. We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman. We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, pornography, etc.) is sinful and offensive to God. (Matthew 15:18-20, 1 Cor. 6:9-10, 1 Tim. 1:9-11)

(The above paragraphs are quotes taken from King's Cathedral's Statement of Faith.)

1 Thessalonians 4:3-7 "It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honorable, not in passionate lust like the pagans, who do not know God; and that in this matter no one should wrong or take advantage of a brother or sister. The Lord will punish all those who commit such sins, as we told you and warned you before. For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life."

King's Christian School Hawaii is a religious institution, and we have a unique Christian environment where we provide a quality education and godly discipleship for each student. For this to be effective, our role is not to be the student's only Christian environment, but to work alongside parents and their church to help encourage each student to live whole-heartedly for God. On occasions in which the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home or the activities of the student are counter to or in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the school teaches, the school reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse admission of an applicant or discontinue enrollment of a current student. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, living in, practicing, condoning, or supporting sexual immorality, including but not limited to, sex outside of marriage, homosexual acts; gender identity different than the birth sex chromosomal level; promoting such practices; or otherwise the inability to support the moral principles of the school (Lev. 18:7-23, Romans 1:27, Matthew 19:4-6).
